The exterior space boasts a very spacious Burma Teak sundeck with three large tables at the stern and bow, decked all around with mattresses, cushions and sunbeds. At the far front of the bow, there is our beautiful bell ship with the Cosmos logo and the image of St Nicholas, the protector of seamen, engraved on it.

The interior of the upper deck offers a large dining table situated near the all-day buffet and bar, so guests can benefit of the amenities on offer (TV, DVD player, music system with extensive collection, etc) and the coffee and tea assortments at their disposal.

At the lower interior, COSMOS features four beautiful cabins, each with a distinct identity. The whole level radiates harmony and calm, complemented by the subtle essence of lavender. All beds on the ship are equipped with COCO MAT mattresses, made from 100% natural hypoallergenic materials (seaweed and coconut fibers) making sure our guests will enjoy a blissful sleep while cruising with M/S COSMOS. We offer our guests also a pillow menu, with a wide variety for each sleeping type, as well as slippers, towels, bedlinen and blankets, all 100% natural.






