Twenty-five islands scatter like lush green standust across the turquoise sea. Steady breezes nudge you toward a new casis every day. In the BVI, your next destination is always in sight. The caves of Norman Island and Treasure Point tantalize snorkelers. Divers explore the famous wreck of the H.M.S. Rhone.

On solid ground the monolithic stones of The Baths stand like nature's Stonehenge by the sea. A barbecued lobster Aregadan style is a meal you'll think back on for the rest of your life. When darkness falls, Willie T's —a moored ship turned rousing watering hole bar—draws a jolly mix of locals and adventurers from all over the world. Whether it's the pod of dolphins racing your bow in the dusky sunset, or the waltz of the water beneath a dazzling starscape, time in the BVI will mark your memory and change the way you think about where you want to go in the world.











Your Sample BVI Cruising Adventure (Sailing or Power Yachts)

- Day 1 At noon, sail to The Bight at Norman Island. Take in the breathtaking scenery and dine under star filled skies.
- Day 2 Enjoy snorkeling the memorable caves at Norman Island and Treasure Point. After lunch, sail to Trellis Bay on Tortola where you'll toast to a fine day and a tropical sunset.
- Day 3 Sail over to Virgin Gorda and anchor off the famous Baths. Have a snorkel before lunch; sail the calm, still waters of Gorda Sound.
- Day 4 Try windsurfing in the Sound today, or kayaking. Go shelling along the beach of Eustacia Island, or snorkeling and swimming. Enjoy sho reside activities and stunning views.
- Day 5 Set sail for beautiful Anegada, home of the Caribbean pink flamingo. Relax on gorgeous stretches of pristine white sand beaches, and enjoy some of the clearest waters and best reefs in the Caribbean.
- Day 6 Try your hand at the helm of your yacht, under the guidance of your captain. Sail to scenic Sandy Cay for lunch. Anchor for the night at Jost Van Dyke.
- Day 7 Enjoy a relaxing two hour sail to Cooper Island. On the way, anchor for lunch at Salt Island. Dive or snorkel over the wreck of the H.M.S. Rhone.
- Day 8 Last day after breakfast, take a morning swim or stroll on the beach. Sail back to Road Town for a noon arrival.



Travel to the Virgin Islands

To discover the BVI's, connect in San Juan, Puerto Rico from most gateway cities and fly directly into Beef Island Tortola. Or choose from a range of low cost jet services from most gateway cities directly into St. Thomas, USVI. From St. Thomas, it's a short ferry ride to your yacht in Road Town, BVI.





The world's third largest barrier reef system is also one of the closest island destinations to North America: the Abacos, just a one-hour flight from Miami or Rt. Lauderdale. Snorkeling among the endless stretches of purple and yellow fan corals, you will swim with spotted eagle rays and massive schools of tropical fish flitting like multicolored glitter over vest coralscapes. The healthy reefs make for dining delicacies of firsh seafood whenever you want it.

Above the surface, miles of pristine, desolate beaches ring pictures que coves – Treasure Cay boests one of the world's top ten beaches. In charming villages like Man-O'-War Cay, residents still build boats in island traditions that reach back through centuries. Stroll the streets of Hope Town, a quaint island village with seaside shops and a candy striped lighthouse. Everywhere you go, the laid-back, easy-going Bahamian attitude is abundant and a favorite among vacationers. The Abaccs offers hundreds of miles of ideal destinations – and the sense that you're always exploring your own private paradise.

- Day 1 Enjoy a leisurely sail from Marsh Harbour to Man-O'-War Cay. Take your snorkel gear to the beach, visit the small settlement or relax on-board and chat with your captain and chef before sitting down to a wonderful meal.
- Day 2 After breakfast and a morning stroll on the beach, set sail for Fowl Cay for some great snorkeling. Anchor in Settlement Harbourfor the night.
- Day 3 Go ashore and walk through this historic settlement before heading north. After lunch, snorkel the barrier reef. A late afternoon swim and dinner prepared by your chef tops off the evening.
- Day 4 Sail for a lunch stop at Manjack Cay, snorkel, kayak and swim; then on to Treasure Cay and one of the world's top 10 beaches!
- Day 5 Sail to Hope Town. This quaint picturesque village is rich in history and offers unique Island boutiques and a famous candy-striped lighthouse.
- Day 6 Visit the secluded and protected anchorages of Lynard Cay.

 Try your hand at kneeboarding or relax and enjoy
 yourself as this will be the backdrop for cocktails at sunset and
 another dazzling dinner prepared to your taste by your chef.
- Day 7 Sail to Matt Lowes Cay. Stop for a swim and lunch at Tahiti Beach, rated one of the world's top ten beaches. Relax and succumb to the peace and serenity of yet another beautiful evening on your yacht, under another star studded sky.
- Day 8 Enjoy breakfast and take a short swim and snorkel before returning to our base at Marsh Harbour.

Travel to Abacos, Bahamas

The Abacos are just 1 hour by air from South Florida, and our base at the Conch Inn Resort is less than five miles from the Marsh Harbour Airport.





A two-hour flight from the southern U.S. lies 3,000 square miles of calm, clear waters protected by the world's second longest reef. The 400 secluded barrier islands of Belize, home to at least 50 species of corals and almost 500 tropical fish species, provide some of the world's best snorkeling and diving. Follow manatees or hover overwhale sharks – in Belize's famously crystalline water you spot exotic marine animals from hundreds of feet away. Anchor off a tranquil sandy island just inside the reef and feel the crunch of waves resonating with the pulse of ocean breezes.

Onshore day-trips reveal jaguars in their native habitation immerse you in a Mayan ruin still partially cloaked in jungle. On land and at sea, Belize's hows you a world that has endured for thousands of years. Unparalleled natural beauty both above and below the surface, accessed by superior sailing in calm, protected waters – it's hard to imagine a getaway so close and so far-away as Belize.











Your Sample Belize Cruising Adventure (Sailing Yachts)

- Day 1 After settling in, your captain heads down the Placencia lagoon to Wippari Cay which offers great snorkeling and excellent fishing.
- Day 2 After breakfast head to South Water Cay. Stroll along the shores of this small island and snorkel the cut to view a wide variety of beautiful marine life.
- Day 3 A short sail brings you to beautiful Tobacco Cay, where you can enjoy great snorkeling. Continue on to Cocca Plum Cay which offers wildlife such as spider monkeys and deer.
- Day 4 Sail down the Inner Channel, with the picturesque coast stretching out across brilliant turquoise waters. Overnight at Lagoon Cay for snorkeling and layaking.



Day 5 Visit the Queen Cays which offer unforgettable snorkeling and diving along the edge of the barrier reef. Go ashore for lunch at the gorgeous beach.


Day 6 The next leg takes you to Ranguana Cay, which affords you an opportunity to go ashore and visit the small resort. Visit Laughing Bird Cay National Park for a day of bird watching and snorkeling.

Day 7 Choose between a visit to No Name Point a good jump off point for a Monkey River Tour or proceed to Placencia Harbour which makes a great stop on the last night for a visit ashore to explore the village.

Day 8 After a morning swim and leisurely breakfast, the final leg of your charter is an easy sail back to the base to begin planning your next Moorings vacation.

Travel to Placencia, Belize

To sail Belizean waters, depart on a direct flight from Miami, Atlanta or Dallas to Belize City; then it's just a short 45-minute flight to Placencia's Airstrip, which is only 10 minutes from The Moorings base at the Laru Beya Resort!




Start in the dense tropical vegetation of St. Lucia. Sail beneath the towering Pitons – 2,000 feet of stone slab rising above the sea. Next manual: Soufriere, the world's only "drive-in" volcano. Bask in mineral pools at the Diamond Baths. Hike St. Vincent to rock carvings over 1,000 years old. On Bequia, morning conch shell calls hint at a long maritime history, as do the model boat builders replicating the whaling sloops of yesteryears. On the private island of Mustique, cosmopolitan celebrities and obscure billionaires rub el bows at Wednesday night jump-ups at the famous Basil's Bar.

Or start in Canouan, and visit the Tobago Cays – a four-island marine preserve sheltered by a horseshoe reef where you swim eye to eye with dozens of sea turtles and zillions of reef fish in protected waters. Dip south to the savory and seldom visited shores of Grenada, where dinnamon and nutmeg lace the breeze. Our Grenadines bases, in the beautiful windward island chain, allow for oustom it ineraries through a place where one trip is hardly enough.

- Day 1 Join your yacht at noon and after lunch in Marigot Bay, sail south down the dramatic St. Lucian coast for The Pitons. Take a mooring north of Petit Piton and walk to the waterfall or visit the sulfur springs.
- Day 2 Embark on a refreshing sail across the channel to St. Vincent. Stop to enjoy lunch and the dramatic scenery. From there, it's a short sail on to Bequia where you'll overnight in picturesque Admiralty Bay.
- Day 3 Enjoy a morning stroll through Bequia's waterfront streets, visit the market or enjoy a swim at one of the Bay's pristing beaches. Sail on to the exclusive island of Mustique, for a drink at Basil's Bar, or take an island tour and relax with the rich and famous.
- Head south to the beautiful Tobago Cays, enjoy spectacular snorkeling, swimming or beach Day 4 combing among the Cays. These small islands really are true paradise.
- After a memorable morning in the Cays, sail over to Palm Island or visit Union Island for lunch. Day 5 Later, visit Mayreau and overnight in Salt Whistle Bay.
- Day 6 Sail north back to Beguia and enjoy a visit to the turtle farm or visit the famous model boat museum.
- Day 7 Sail back to St. Lucia and anchor off Anse Chastanet for lunch and a cool swim. Sail overnight in the secluded Anse Cochon Bay.
- Day8 Enjoy a refreshing swim before returning to The Moorings Base.





- Day 2 Sail around the northern side of the island to the charming town of Grand Case for lunch. After lunch, set sail, for the pretty town of Marigot for the evening.
- Day 3 Leave the French side for a taste of British Anguilla. On your way, stop, over at Sandy Island for a scenic lunch and refreshing swim.
- It's a short hop north to the uninhabited island of Tintamarre with its desolate beaches and mineral spring mud baths. In the afternoon, Day 4 head to Grand Case Bay famous for its spectacular sunsets.
- Day 5 Set sail for St. Bart's, the most cosmopolitan island in the Caribbean, where we anchor for the evening of f Gustavia. Experience the town of Gustavia with its quaint shops.
- After a leisurely breakfast, stop at Colombier Bay for a relaxing afternoon Day 6 with exquisite surroundings and fantastic snorkeling.
- Day 7 Depart St. Bart's for the island of Ile Fourche where you can snorkellamong the many sea turtles that live there. After lunch, sail to the quiet anchorage of Pinel Island for the night.


Travel to Oyster Pond, St. Martin

Take a direct flight from Miami, New York or Toronto to St. Martin. The base is located on the east coast of the French side at Captain Oliver's Marina at Oyster Pond. Princess Juliana Airport is located on the Dutch side, which is a 45-minute taxi ride.

The marine life swarming the waters of the Sea of Cortez is among the most abundant gatherings on earth. Find yourself awed as pods of dolphins numbering in the thousands sweep past your bow. Experience the enormity of whales breaching, their huge eyes as curious about you as you are about them. In mangrove bays, thousands of exotic birds breed and feed. On shore you can hike sere hills through forests of Cardon cacti 70 feet tall and two centuries old.

Easy navigation and sand-bottomed anchorages allow you to enjoy the vast stretches of empty beaches, and the small seaside villages where we looming people prepare delicious meals. The ever-changing colors of the landscape mirrors the most magnificent sunsets you could see.

- Day 1 Board your yacht at 10:00am and cast off on a short 6 mile cruise to Caleta Lobos. Enjoy some shallow water snorkeling among small coral formations and the ever changing colors of the rocky terrain.
- Day 2 After breakfast depart for Los Islotes where you'll swim, snorkel and admire the sea lion colonies along the way. After lunch, visit Ensenada Grande with its pink volcanic cliffs—recently recognized as one of the most beautiful beaches in the world.
- Day 3 Depart for the island of San Francisco. Here, you can explore the well known cactus forests, and the peace and serenity of a large agoon.
- Day 4 Enjoy a leisurely 32 mile cruise to Puerto Gatos and admire the scenic coastline and bounty of sea-life along the way. If you enjoy fishing, this is an opportune time to catch a few grouper or tuna. Or you may run into Manuel—a local fisherman in the small anchorage of Puerto Gatos, who has fresh lobster and fish.
- Day 5 After enjoying breakfast in the picturesque anchorage of Puerto Gatos, power on to Candalleros point for some great snorkeling before arriving at Puerto Escondido for the evening. Take a taxi to the town of Loreto to enjoy the streets of this quaint and historic town.
- Day 6 Power 24 miles back to Agua Verde where you can swim in the stunning turquoise waters and breathtaking scenery.

 Head over to Isla Santa Catalina to explore an awesome giant barrel cactus, and some great fishing on the northern and southern points of this island. Motor over to Punta Ballena for some great snorkeling, then over to San Everista for the evening.
- Day 7. Spend the morning in the area exploring the anchorages of San Jose and San Francisco.
- Day 8 Enjoy a leisurely swim before breakfast, and take in the breathtaking surroundings as you motor back to The Moorings base for a 10:00am departure.

- Day 1 (Saturday): Step aboard and settle in with a cocktail and hors d'oeuvres as your captain pilots your luxury yacht to the nearby picturesque bay of Chiaia.
- Day 2 After breakfast and briefing with your captain, leave Procida for a 1 hour cruise to Ischia and lunch at either Araganese Castle or Sant 'Angelo. In the afternoon, set sail for Ventotene, an Island which brings you into direct contact with nature, well away from city chaos.
- Day 3 Set sail for Porza, where you will anchor at Frontone Bay or Chiaia di Luna Bay. Take a leisurely walk ashore for an aperitivo on the beach and then back on board for dinner under the stars.
- Day 4 From Ponza, cruise to Palmarola Island, uninhabited apart from a few restaurants open in summer and only accessible from the sea.

 Spend the afternoon swimming and snorkeling.
- Day 5 After breakfast we leave for Ventotene where lunch will be served at Santo Stefano. We then return to ischia and anchorat Cava dell' isola for the night.
- Day 6 Before leaving, spend the morning swimming in the hot natural waters which form part of this bay. From Ischia cruise to Capri, dock for the night and visit the island at your leisure.
- Day 7 After breakfast you have the morning to further explore Capri. In the afternoon, return to Procida and anchor for the night in the small fishermen's harbour of Corricella.
- Day 8 Leaving Corricella we return to the Procida base.
